Subject: Revised 2011-12 P-2 Property Tax Estimates

In order to provide additional time to calculate estimates of the 2011-12 remittances to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) from the Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund (RPTTF), the submission deadline for the County Auditors was extended to June 11, 2012. Enclosed is a copy of the revised 2011-12 P-2 Property Tax Revenue Estimates reported to the California Department of Education. When comparing the revised 2011-12 P-2 Estimates to the initial 2011-12 P-2 Estimated property taxes submission, we noted the following countywide changes:

- Secured Taxes has decreased by \$30,166,026 or 1.93%.
- The Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund (ERAF) been adjusted by \$5,709,624 or 6.59%.
- Community Redevelopment, which includes the Pass-Through Payments and Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund (RPTTF) Residual Payments, increased by \$24,650,704.
- Total Taxes including Community Redevelopment increased by \$194,302 (Total Taxes do not include Miscellaneous Taxes/Other Appropriate Local Revenues or Subventions from Los Angeles County for Fullerton Joint Union High School District).

This memo is being submitted to provide you with a detailed explanation of our 2011-12 property tax revenue estimates for schools.

Type Tax Revenue

- 8. <u>Homeowners Subvention</u>: 100 percent of FY 2011-12 Homeowners Exemption Claim filed on October 2011.

- 10. Education Revenue Augmentation Fund: There was insufficient cash in ERAF on April 30, 2012 to make the VLF, Triple Flip, and County Equity (R&T 97.80(b)(2)) payments on May 8, 2012. As such the Auditor-Controller made a negative ERAF apportionment which reduced the total estimated FY 2011-12 ad valorem property tax revenue allocated to non-basic aid school districts and community college districts in the county to cover the cash shortfall in ERAF. However, we also plan to partially pay down the negative ERAF with apportionments in June and July.
